

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## **Brereton: Archaeological Statement**

## 1 Archaeological Potential

1.1 The conclusion from the Assessment of Brereton is that the dispersed, rural settlement pattern of the historic town renders an Area of Archaeological Potential both impractical to define and inappropriate for this settlement type. The archaeological potential of the town will therefore be considered in terms of sites identified in the County Sites and Monuments Record.
