# 1. Vertical Aerial Photography: Luftwaffe Aerial Photographs (1940)

# Description

This survey is compiled from rare wartime aerial photographs taken by a reconnaissance aircraft of the Luftwaffe's Luftflotte 2 at the height of the Battle of Britain, on September 4th 1940. Having made its made its way round the Lizard and up the Irish Sea the German plane crossed the English coast and snapped its three Zeiss Reihenbilder cameras on just north of Liverpool. After recording the town the aircraft continued on up the Mersey, recording a swathe of Cheshire from Ellesmere Port in the north to Whitchurch in the south before passing out of the County in the direction of Cheltenham, where it finally it switched off its three cameras, and turned for France.

# 3. Vertical Aerial Photography: 25m RAF National Survey (1945-1948)

# Description

This was a national aerial survey flown by the RAF from 1944 (3 Group RAF and then by the newly created RAF Central Photographic Establishment). The photography was undertaken by 540 and 58 Squadrons using de Havilland Mosquito aircraft. Photography was also undertaken by 541 Squadron; possibly with Avro Lancaster aircraft.

The majority of the western air photographs date from 17th January 1947. Some of the Wirral, Warrington and Macclesfield photographs are from August 1945 and are quite distinctive due to their grade A quality. The original prints are available through Cheshire Archives and Local Studies, but are largely restricted to the southern and western parts of Cheshire, but do include the Wirral. The English Heritage Archive holds a larger archive of the original prints and negatives.

For the digital mosaic, photographs were sourced from those held by Cheshire Archives and Local Studies. Photographs and negatives were also sourced from the Historic England Archive (NMR) at Swindon.
